The ACLU position is given after each question. The score column indicates the number of questions on which the candidate is in agreement with ACLU policy.

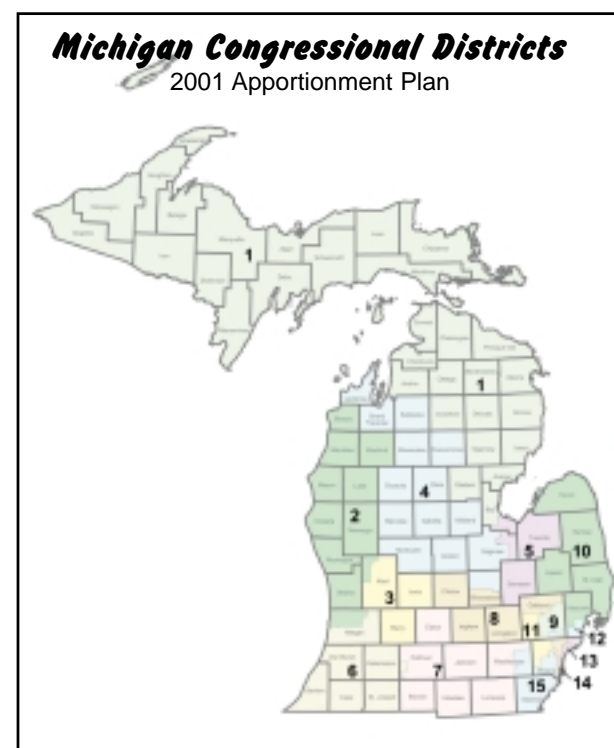
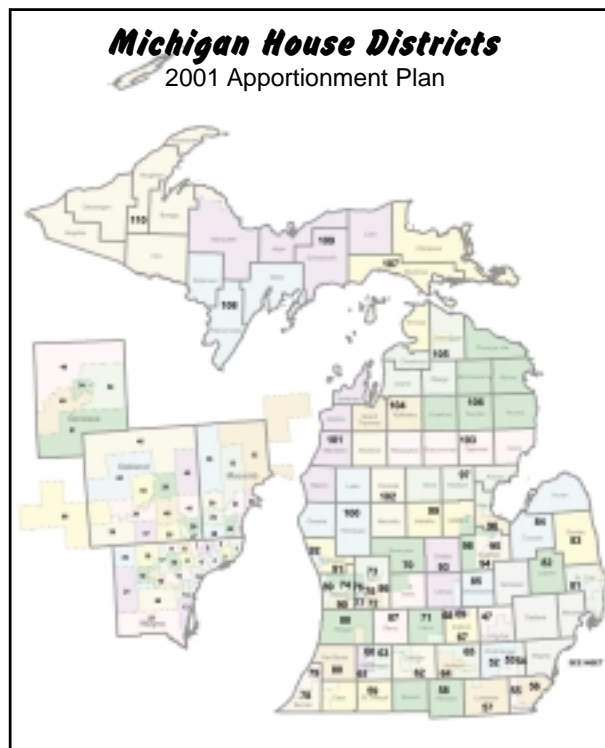
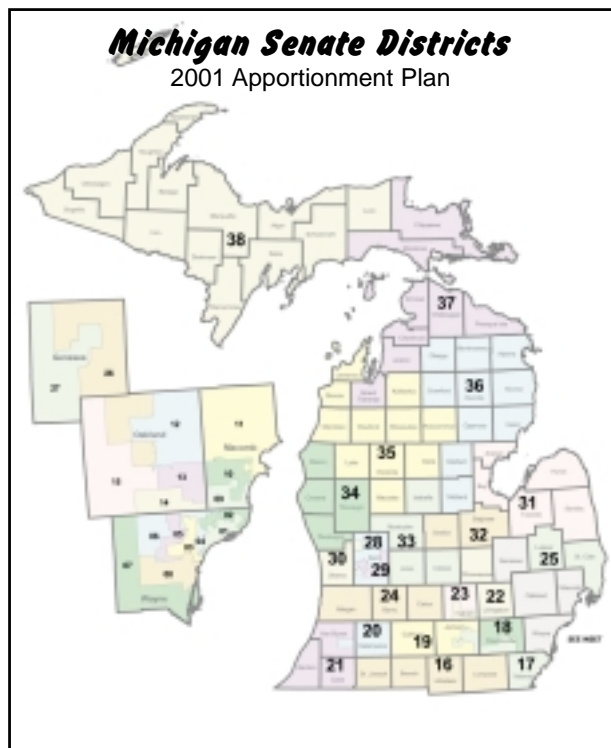
Due to space constraints, candidates were limited to "yes" or
