TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER


For the reasons placed on the record at a September 28, 2004, hearing, plaintiff's motion for a temporary restraining order is hereby GRANTED, to the extent it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. City of Troy is hereby temporarily restrained from enforcing Troy Ordinances Chapter 85-A(3)(b)(2) (30 day political sign requirement), and 85A(3)(b)(1) (two political sign maximum) as applied to plaintiff Kent Fehribach, Jr.;

2. This Order is binding only upon the parties to this action, their officers, agents, servants, employees and attorneys, and upon those in active concert or participation, until further Order of the Court;

3. The parties shall appear on Friday, October 8, 2004, at 11:00 a.m., before the Honorable Paul V. Gadola, in Flint, Michigan, for a hearing on plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction.
