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On August 24, 2016 at approximately 8:30 p.m., Detroit Sector dispatch ((b) (7)(E)) received a call from Michigan State Police Trooper (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) requesting identification assistance for a subject he encountered during a traffic stop at the intersection of (b) (7)(E) in Royal Oak, Michigan. Border Patrol Agent (BPA) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was dispatched to meet Trooper (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) at the scene. While enroute, Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) contacted Trooper (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to collect the name and date of birth of the subject in question, and relayed the information to Detroit Sector dispatch for records checks. Dispatch relayed to Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that the subject had no immigration record.

Border Patrol Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) arrived at the scene and met with Trooper (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). Trooper (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) informed Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that the subject was in the front passenger seat of the vehicle which he had performed the traffic stop with (a white Toyota bearing Michigan license plate (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)). Trooper (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) also informed Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that the subject was not able to provide any state-issued identification, but provided instead an identification card labeled (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), as well as an El Salvadorian identification card, both bearing the subject's image and likeness.

Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) identified himself to the subject as a Border Patrol Agent, and asked him if he had any valid identification, or immigration documents. The subject, later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (D.O.B. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), Country of birth; El Salvador, Country of citizenship; El Salvador) stated that he did not have any. Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) then asked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) what country he was a citizen of, to which he replied "El Salvador". Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) asked (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) if he was present in the United States illegally, to which (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) replied "yes".

BPA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) then took (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) into custody and transported him to the (b) (7)(E) Border Patrol Station for processing.

Trooper (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) cited the driver of the vehicle for no headlight and no proof of insurance (ticket# (b) (7)(E)).

Once at the station, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was fingerprinted on the (b) (7)(E) system which returned with the following immigration and criminal information:

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claims that he does not remember near what city he crossed when crossing into to the United States from Mexico. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that once he was in the United States he stayed one day in Arizona and was driven to Michigan in a small white truck by an unknown driver. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that he has been living in Michigan ever since. He claimed that he lived in an apartment at (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) in Troy, Michigan until September 2015, when he moved to his recent address at (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) in Madison Heights, Michigan.</p> <p>(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claims to currently be working for (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) as a Chef making approximately \$16.00 per hour.</p> <p>(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) appeared to be lucid and appeared and claimed to be in good health during transport and during processing at the Detroit Border Patrol Station.</p> <p>(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was advised of his right to contact the El Salvadorian Consulate at approximately 10:51 p.m., which he declined.</p> <p>During interviewing, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was able to accurately describe the home at his current address at (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) in Madison Heights, Michigan. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claims to attend his local church multiple times a week. He also claims to have attended (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was married in July of 2016 to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) a United States Citizen. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claims to work at the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) as a Chef and was a key individual in creating the menu that the restaurant currently uses.</p> <p>(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) does not fall within the guidelines for prosecutorial priorities and is being released as a Prosecutorial Discretion as per Presidential Executive Order.</p> <p>(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was processed and released from the (b) (7)(E) Border Patrol Station under his own recognizance along with all of his personal belongings.</p>
