



After entering the United States the subject stated that she traveled to Florida for work and stayed for approximately five months before coming to Michigan for work and to reside.</p> <p>INADMISSABILITY:</p> <p>(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is a native and citizen of Mexico as are both of her parents. She has never had any documents that would allow her to be or remain in the United States legally. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is inadmissible under Section 212(a)(6)(A)(i) of the INA, in that she entered the United States at a time or place not designated by the Attorney General and was not then admitted, paroled or inspected by an immigration officer. Subject is also a native and citizen of Mexico as are both of her parents.</p> <p>FACTS OF ARREST:</p> <p>On August 5, 2015 at approximately 1850 hours, St. Clair County central dispatch advised Capac Police of an assault between several male subjects near Capac, MI. While on patrol in their assigned area, Agents (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) met roadside with Capac Police who advised them that one of the suspects in the assault had fled on foot and was possibly in need of law enforcement assistance. The suspect, later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was</p>

located a short time later on (b) (7)(E) in Mussey Twp. MI.

Capac Police along with Agents (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) made contact with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and identified themselves as United States Border Patrol Agents and asked him for his identification. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that he did not have any identification on him. Agents then asked him what country he is a citizen of and if he has immigration documents to be in the United States legally, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) advised he is a citizen of Mexico and does not have immigration documents to be in the United States legally. After speaking with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) agents determined that he is sixteen years old. Agents then allowed the subject to use his cell phone and speak with his mother prior to taking him into custody. During the phone conversation agents also spoke with the mother and it was determined that she also was in the United States illegally. The subjects mother identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) further advised that she would meet with Border Patrol Agents at their office in (b) (7)(E) MI. Agents then transported (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to the (b) (7)(E) Border Patrol station for further processing.

Upon arriving at the (b) (7)(E) Border Patrol Station, Agents provided food, water and offered medical assistance to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) prior to beginning processing of the subject. At this time the subject refused any medical attention. A short time later the subjects mother arrived to pick him up and to be processed. After the arrival of his mother the subject was then evaluated by Border Patrol Agent (EMT) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) in the presence of his mother. After the arrival of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), agents again asked her what country she is a citizen of and if she has immigration documents to be in or remain in the United States legally and she advised that she is a citizen of Mexico and does not have immigration documents.

It was also discovered during a brief interview that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) initial altercation in Capac, MI was the result of him being engaged in a fight with another unknown subject over a female. The subject was advised to make a complaint with the Capac Police Department if desired upon his release. Subject was also advised by Border Patrol Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (EMT) that he should seek medical attention to make sure he does not have any injuries from the earlier altercation. The subjects mother signed off on a medical waiver advising that she did not wish to seek medical attention at this time and that she would further reevaluate her son after their release from Border Patrol custody.

EMPLOYMENT:

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claimed that she has worked for (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) every summer for the past ten years. She also advised that she goes to Florida in the winter for work.
