NARRATIVE:

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ENTRY: **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** claims to have last entered the United States illegally via Chicago O'Hare Airport in June of 2000. **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** has no proof that this is when he actually entered the United States, and there is no record stating that this was in fact his last entry date.

TRAVEL: **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** recollection of his entry is not the best, as he was only nine years old when he entered. **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** states that his parents were already in the United States in June of 2000 and that he was living with his grandmother in Mexico. In June of 2000, **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** stated that a friend of his father came to his house and explained that **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** would be joining his parents in the United States. He does not recall the name of this person. **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** traveled to the Distrito Federal Airport with his father's friend and boarded a

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plane for Chicago, IL. **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** stated that while in flight his father's friend told him not to speak upon arriving in Chicago and stated that he would do all of the talking. **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** stated that the two of them passed through U.S. Customs quickly upon arriving in Chicago. He stated that his father's friend spoke briefly with a female U.S. Customs Officer and they were allowed to pass through.

**(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** was then taken to a McDonald's Restaurant near the airport, where he was reunited with his father. **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** lived in Marshalltown, IA for a few years. He then moved to Cleveland, OH and lived there for two years. He moved to Detroit, MI with his family in 2010. He has lived and worked in the Detroit area ever since.

**INADMISSIBILITY:** **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** is a citizen of Mexico. He has never had any documents that would allow him to be, or remain, in the United States legally. **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** is inadmissible under section 212(a) (6) (A) (i) of the INA, in that he entered the United States at a place not designated by the Attorney General and was not then admitted or paroled after inspection by an immigration officer.

**FACTS OF ARREST:** On May 13, 2016 Border Patrol Agent (BPA) **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** and BPA **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** were **(b) (7)(E)** in a marked Border Patrol unit. **(b) (7)(E)** is a direct route away from the border and the metropolitan Detroit area. **(b) (7)(E)** is

to this, both agents have arrested numerous illegal aliens traversing this stretch of highway in recent times.

At approximately 10:15 AM a white van passed the agents' location. As the vehicle passed, the agents noted that both subjects were sitting rigid in their seats, staring straight ahead through the windshield. These subjects did not seem as relaxed as most of the motoring public passing the agents that morning. The agents also noted that the side of the van read, **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** Agents have arrested numerous illegal aliens over the past year and a half in **(b) (7)(E)** (reference **(b) (7)(E)**)

**(b) (7)(E)**. The agents decided to take a closer look at the vehicle.

As the agents caught up to the vehicle, it began to slow drastically. The speed limit for this area is 70 mph and the driver dropped to 55 mph. This is a behavior consistent with someone who is aware of Border Patrol or law enforcement presence. **(b) (7)(E)**

**(b) (7)(E)**

The agents pulled up alongside the driver's side window and noted that the two occupants were sitting rigid in their seats. The driver appeared to be gripping the steering wheel tightly, looking straight ahead the entire time the agents paralleled the van. The passenger appeared to be doing something on his phone. Neither subject looked at the

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agents once as they continued to parallel the van. This struck the agents as odd.  
**(b) (7)(E)**

The agents reduced speed and ran a registration check on the license plate displayed on the rear of the van (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) through Detroit Sector Radio. The agents were advised that the van was registered out of Detroit, MI. It is a well-known fact amongst agents at the (b) (7)(E) Station that there is a large population of illegal aliens in Detroit. In o this, a large majority of the (b) (7)(E) that agents have made arrests from have been registered out of (b) (7)(E)

Due to all of the above information, officer experience led the agents to suspect that these subjects might be illegally present in the United States. BPA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) activated the emergency lights and sirens on the agent's marked unit and the van yielded near (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E). The agents approached the van and identified themselves as United States Border Patrol Agents. There was a third subject sitting in the back of the van. The agents questioned each subject individually as to what country they were citizens of.

After a brief field interview, BPA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) determined that the front seat passenger, later identified as (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was a citizen of Mexico, not in possession of any valid immigration documents that would allow him to be, or remain, in the United States legally. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was taken into custody at that time.

BPA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) determined that the other two subjects were USCs and they were released from the scene with the van, after it was determined that the three were on their way to work and no smuggling had occurred.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was transported to the (b) (7)(E) Station for processing.

**EMPLOYMENT:** (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is currently working as a subcontractor for (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). He earns approximately \$20.00 per hour.

At the (b) (7)(E) Station (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) fingerprints and biographical data were entered into the (b) (7)(E) computer systems. These systems revealed the following:

**IMMIGRATION HISTORY:** None found.

**CRIMINAL HISTORY:** None found.

**HEALTH:** (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) claims to be, and appears to be, in good health.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was asked if he would like to speak with the Mexican consulate and he declined to do so.

**DISPOSITION:** (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not fall under any of the Department of Homeland Security's prioritized immigration levels and was released due to Prosecutorial Discretion.
